#### 7 Changes in Income and Expenditure

### **Council Tax Support Grant**

This is a reduction by Hart District Council.

#### Rental Income

The rent increases annually.

### **Burial Fees**

The increase in income is due to an large increase in the number of burials.

#### Events (AFD)

This is the Armed Forces Day and is only a large event every other year.

### Other Income

This year it includes the insurance claim money received.

#### **Grants for SID**

Last year a grant was received for a SID which was spent within the Traffic and Transport costs, as below.

#### Grant for Resurfacing Footpath 7

Last year a grant was received for resurfacing footpath 7 which was spent within the Traffic and Transport costs.

#### **Grant for Neighbourhood Plan**

The is a grant received for the Neighbourhood Plan this year.

### **General Administration**

This includes a one off cost for the door of £2,500 and a new laptop for £579 this year. £1,200 was also spent setting up email addresses for new counsellors and the associated IT support. There are also increases of £2,301 in the Clerks Salary due to overtime, and the Staff Salaries of £2,302 due to increase in contracted hours. This also means NI has increased by £650 and Pensions by £799.

# S137 Grants

This year there have been several grant applications, including North Warnborough Village Hall for £3,000, Mayhill School for £1,250, Little Wings for £400 and Odiham and North Warnborough Bowling Club of £500.

#### Other Grants

This was a decrease in the RAF grant this year.

### **Planning and Development**

This includes one off costs for a housing needs survey this year.

### Traffic and Transport

Last year this included £2,990 for Footpath and £3,290 for the SID for which Grants were received as above.

### Community

Last year £5,000 was contributed towards the Magna Carta celebrations as one off.

This year it includes the cost of the defibrillator of £1,382, cost of a firework display with the Lions of £2,000 and the budget for promotion of the village was also spent this year including new signs and a tourism leaflet.

### **Amenity Areas**

This year the costs include a contribution to re-tarmac of £4,000, redecorate the toilets of £2,200, an increase in spending on the allotments of £950 and a combination of this years and last years unspent budget for building maintenance giving an extra cost of £11,000 spent on the North and South Chapels.

## Neighbourhood Plan

The completion of the neighbourhood plan was agreed by the Council, and once approved the plan will last for 18 years. The costs have been incurred over the course of last year and this year, with costs increasing this year as the end of the project is approaching. The project should be completed next year.
