- CC01/21 To receive and accept apologies for absence**
Apologies were received and accepted from Cllrs Macphee and Fraser.

- CC04/21 Approval of minutes**
RESOLVED

- CC06/21 Community Awards sub-committee**
The changes to the terms of reference were confirmed and it was agreed to send to Full Council for approval.

Councillors discussed options to have flowers in the High Street that were alternative to hanging baskets on the lampposts which was no longer permissible. An option suggested was to install free standing poles to hang the baskets from. It was agreed to enquire whether it would be permissible to implement new hanging basket poles within the conservation area.

Councillors reviewed the recent Great British Spring Clean event and were pleased with the litter that was collected. It was agreed to support the new Lions initiative to hold monthly litter picks and asked that the Lions should give the details to OPC to support via social media.

It was agreed to purchase 20 OPC branded high vis vests for use at future litter picks and other events.

Heritage Open Days 2021

It was noted the Heritage Open Day theme for 2021 was food and drink. The Odiham Society had indicated that as part of their plans for the events they would be organising a self-guided walk of past and current eating and drinking establishments in Odiham. John Fleming had contacted the Clerk to arrange to update OPC's walking map to be used for this purpose and for general use and had indicated The Odiham Society would apply for a Community Grant Award to help meet the cost of amending and producing the new map.
