# Greening Odiham and North Warnborough



This card is the start of our community action for the **Greening Campaign**. Acting together we will reduce our carbon footprint, save money and help combat Climate Change. We will move on to further mass action but first we can all take action in our homes. Once you have committed to **five of the actions below**, please display this card so it can be seen from the street by **31st October**. If you have a long drive, tie something green to your gate or some other signal to show you have joined the Greening Campaign to **support your community**.

Already doing some of the challenges? Go to the Energy Savings Trust website and pick some different ones. Then put the card up in the window to encourage others!

- Turn off all standbys and inactive appliances** and save **60kg of CO<sub>2</sub>** from going into the atmosphere and **£55\* C**
- Turn off lights** when leaving a room (non LED) and stop **25kg of CO<sub>2</sub>** going into the atmosphere and **save £20\* C**
- Turn the thermostat down by 1°C** and you can **stop 325kg of CO<sub>2</sub>** being emitted, it also saves your household **£110\***
- Go vegetarian an extra day** a week and the CO<sub>2</sub> savings on average are **563kg CO<sub>2</sub>e** and **£189 C**
- Line or rack dry clothes** reduces **CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 65kg** and saves **£35\***
- Reduce each normal shower time** by one minute (4 people) saves **35kg of CO<sub>2</sub>** and **£7\* C**
- Boil only the amount of water needed** and you can stop **12kg CO<sub>2</sub>** going into the atmosphere, **saving £6 a year** off household bills\*
- Replacing 6 incandescent bulbs with LEDs** will reduce **CO<sub>2</sub> by 65kg** and save **£36 a year\***

We will be counting the cards displayed between 31st October and 7th November to calculate how much CO<sub>2</sub> we will save together. Please ensure your card is visible during this period and if your house is not easy to see from the street, display something green at your entrance to show you are a part of the campaign.
