

### Last year

- Considered approximately 130 planning applications in the parish (mid April).
- Considered many tree applications in the parish and tried to ensure the protection of as many as possible.
- Negotiations with developer of Crownfields NP site to ensure contributions to the Parish are acceptable.
- Development of the updated Conservation Area Character Appraisal.
- Submitted a proposal for the listing for The Bell as an Asset of Community Value. This was successful but is a new buyer has not come forward this will not stop its change of use into a residential building.



## Planning & Development Committee

### Last year

- Presentations from a prospective different developer of the NP site on Hook Road.
- Neighbourhood Plan Annual Monitoring Report available online.
- Involved in the steering group for a rural exception site on land adjacent to Rough's Cottage. The affordable rental units have been allocated but the shared ownership properties are still available.



# Neighbourhood Plan

### Cllr Pam Verdon

- Neighbourhood Plan Monitoring Group meeting in February. The group is made up of members
  of the Planning Committee and two members of the public who were involved in the production
  of the Plan.
- Annual Monitoring Report now published online which gives more detail about other parts of the Plan as well as the sites:

- Land at 4 Western Lane Building is well under way at this site.
- Crumplins Yard properties are now occupied
- Albion Farm no further applications have been submitted for this site.
- Land at Dunleys no further contact received regarding this site.
- Land at Hook Road application refused in June 2021. Revised application presented to OPC in March this year.
- Land next to Crownfields outline planning application has been granted subject to the approval
  of the S106 contributions.






# Amenity Areas Committee Cllr Rowena Coleman

### Last year

- Recorded asset portfolio. Complete review underway.
- New noticeboards on the High Street and at North Warnborough.
- Full tender process for new cemetery grounds maintenance contract.
- Worked alongside new grounds contractor tackling outstanding issues.
- Funded Ranger services for Odiham Common and Broad Oak Common.
- Contributed towards the Basingstoke Canal management.
- Re-let Chapel Cottage to secure important income for the Parish.
- Maintained 2020 allotment fee. Small increase to cemetery fees.
- Significant hedge cutting and tree works in Odiham Cemetery.
- Several large repairs to wooden play equipment.
- Started an earmarked reserve for play equipment.
- Thinned out planting around the Bufton Field play area.






